The annual fund raising drive is for securing funds to be distributed to various not-for-profit organizations located within or serving the Johnson County, Indiana area.

No Place to Call Home Coordination takes place in 3 parts: entry, coordinated case management and coordinated financial assistance. First, No Place to Call Home Coordination provides a single point of entry and assessment into the program for those who are homeless. Second, No Place to Call Home coordinates case management providers in the county and assigns clients to the most appropriate provider based on their presenting needs. Third, No Place to Call Home coordinates financial resources for clients to assist in addressing their housing needs. 43 households representing 109 individuals were served in this program.

COVID-19 expenses:
United Way has received assistance from the Indiana United Way, the City of Greenwood and other sources to provide financial assistance, resource connection and/or case management services to individuals affected by COVID-19 through a reduction in hours; job loss; layoffs; job loss due to childcare issues; illness or death in the family. The affected individual will be referred by the United Way of Johnson County Helpline to Gateway Services to develop a plan of action to address the individual's needs. United Way received \$416,284 of local funds during the fiscal year to use toward the communities' COVID needs and has \$433,193 of funds remaining to be spent over the next operating year.
